# Lights and Shadows from the Dishman Hills, July-August, 1997

## NATURE TRAIL GRANT

Foundation Northwest has awarded the Dishman Association a \$5,200 grant for the construction of a Nature Interpretative trail in the Camp Caro area. The trail will include an information kiosk at trail head, an outdoor classroom site (benches), and a set of information stops that are keyed to a brochure which will be available at trail head. Existing trails will be used including the old Boy Scout nature loop tail through the Enchanted Canyon and by Caro Cliff.

We plan to use this facility both as an environmental education tool, and as means of passing information about Spokane Conservation issues to the public. The trail's dialog will be designed to tell the geologic, biologic, and human stories of the Dishman Hills rather than just list plant species. The area's schools will hopefully be major users of the trail and we plan to spend some time getting out a mailing introducing the project to them. We also envision some interesting spin-off projects along the lines environmental lesson plans that will help students understand better their natural setting in the Spokane area.

Construction of the trail's components will start this fall. The project will be a joint effort with Spokane County and Washington State, who will supply resources where they can. While the Northwest Foundation has generously awarded the capital funds for the project, it's our responsibility to see the job completed by supplying the labor for planning, construction, installation, maintenance, and running of the trail.
